Assistance to pay no more than 2 month's rent arrears for low income individuals who are not in receipt of OW or ODSP. Tenants are eligible once in a 2 year period. Payments are made directly to the landlord. Rent Bank cannot be used for first and last month's rent. Combined family income must be under \$24,000 net for current year unless there are extenuating circumstances.
